## CELEBRATION WITH A FIZZ

On Tuesday April 19th 1966 Hethersett Hawks entertained Norwich Icenians in the first-ever competitive match at the new cycle speedway track on the Memorial Playing Field. On the same date fifty years later 20 current members aged from 6 to 62 rolled up for their regular Tuesday Club Night in glorious but chilly sunshine to find the night going with a fizz.

In addition to the normal mix of graded races, time trials, a manic 9-a-side relay race, handicap races and the popular 30-lap eliminator race, they, plus committee members and supporters, were treated to some champagne / soft drinks and cakes to celebrate this very special anniversary for the village club started by a group of teenagers all those years ago.

With 20 members there it was a crazy night with the highlight being the appearance later on of former star Hawk of the late 70s/early 80s Glyn Morgan who, having watched the previous week, decided to have a go. He looked in good shape and certainly was under-estimated by the handicapper as he won Rider of the Night with 13 points!! Also Dan Butler put in his appearance at Club Night this season. He set a personal best time, as did Sam Crossley while Alfie Holmes set his best time of the season. The climax Eliminator saw those key rivals Harley Hamill and Owen Wells battle it out to the end with Harley winning for the fifth time.

Thanks to everyone for making it a very special night for me.

The club will be having a day of special events on Saturday May 21st at the track and hope to welcome along as many ex-riders as can make it to share their memories and maybe show their old skills on the track before a social evening at Hethersett Social Club.

Then on Sunday June 26th club members will parade through the village streets at the head of the annual Run-the-Square fun run which will be followed in the afternoon with the staging of the Norfolk Championships at the track.

Later this year a book will be published cataloguing the history of the Club.

## EAGLES SWOOP IN

The Hawks suffered their first South-East League Division 1 defeat of the season when Ipswich Eagles visited the Memorial Playing Field. The Hawks were without four of their first-team squad for a variety of reasons and the strong Ipswich side soon took command and led by 15 points at the interval. After the break the Hawks rallied with wins from Leigh Cossey, Olly Buxton and Dan Butler to support Dan Chambers who only lost one race all afternoon. A 7-2 win in the final race meant that the Hawks only lost the second half by one point, but they had the advantage of inside gates throughout this half.
